Our stage tech will begin immediately packing our backline at the conclusion of our performance.



Production Notes:

- We prefer not to have a full drum shield placed in front of our drummer, Steve. Small, round cymbal shields are acceptable.
- We prefer to have wired microphones, especially for lead vocal. If you must use wireless mics, please ensure they are fully charged. Please also see next note below.
- The Lead Guitarist's vocal microphone line will need to be connected to a vocal processor, so please mute the channel to facilitate this at load-in/pre-soundcheck. Curt has a dedicated 10 foot XLR cable to go from processor to the microphone. No wireless microphone.
- For keyboards, Glenn can run a single, mono mix from his keyboard amp, or can run stereo if you provide two (2) stereo DI boxes, or four (4) mono DI boxes.
- When available, the drum riser must be either non-skid or carpeted surface, minumum 8' x 8'.
- Under no circumstances should a ground be lifted from any backline device that is powered directly by 120VAC mains. If noise is present, isolation of the device in question should be done via DI box, or other means, including removing/swapping any venue-provided cables, etc.
- We prefer no audio/video recordings of our soundchecks, so please advise staff or anyone present of this when possible.
- At the conclusion of our performance, before removing mic stands and cables from the stage, please ensure our personal items such as capos, guitar pick holders, 10 foot mic cable, and other items are removed. Our stage tech will usually do this.
- Please ensure there is adequate lighting on stage and load-out area for removal of all our backline, until the stage has been cleared and redundancy check done.
